Global Care Packages provide children who live in places devastated by war, natural disasters, and poverty with school supplies and toys that bring much needed joy and hope. This opportunity allows us to reach out to God's children around the world. This year's bags will be distributed in many countries where Lutheran Hour Ministries have ministry centers. The supplies are to be packed in bags purchased from LHM. The cost for each bag is \$5. We are asking that each family consider donating \$5 to purchase one bag. Our goal is to pack 200 bags during the months of September and October.
