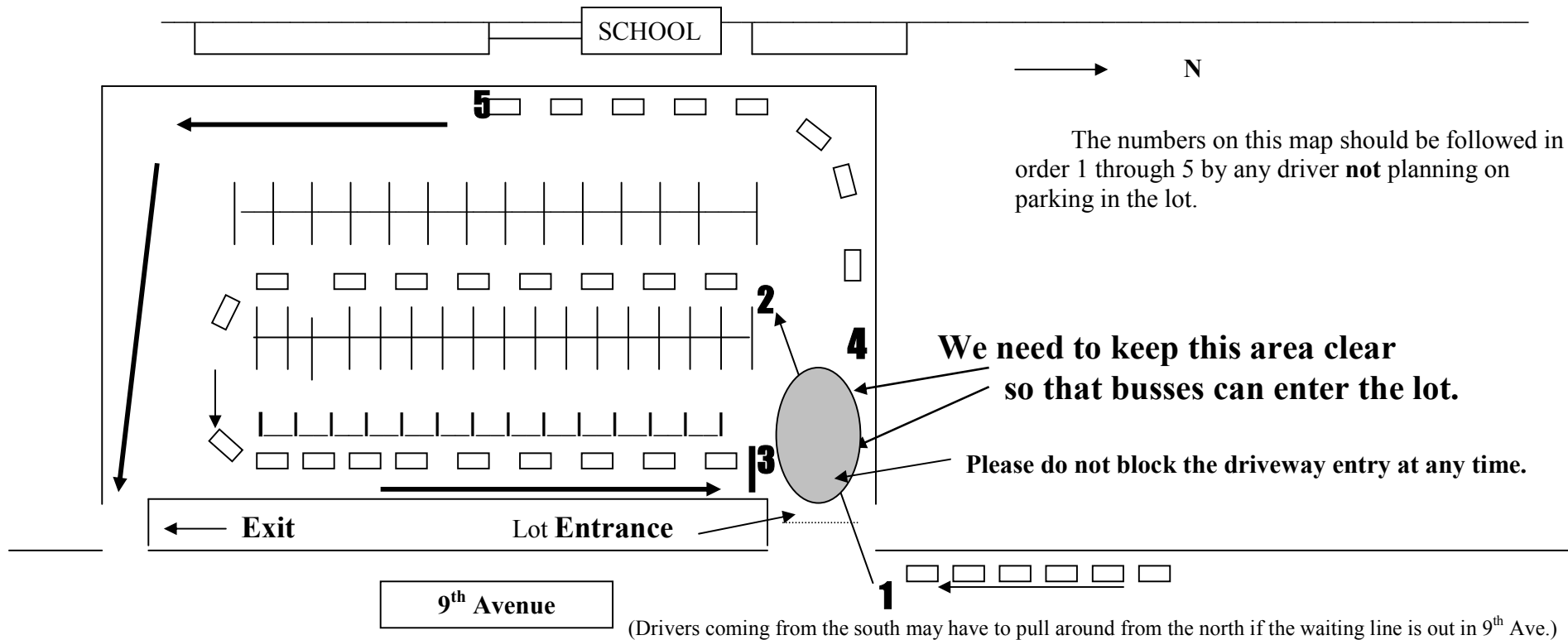


Line-up Procedure for Student Pickup



If I am a driver, where do I go? Yes, this may appear to be complex, but study this carefully and it can be carried out successfully.

- A. Enter the lot at point 1 if there is room in the lot.
- B. Pull into the lane at point 2 and proceed all the way around to point 3. If you are not going to be the first car in line, proceed forward until you reach the last vehicle in line.
- C. When approaching the lot if you see (from point 1) that there is no room to pull behind the last vehicle at point 2 without blocking the drive (shown by the dotted box) then remain along the curb at point 1 until the line has moved forward enough to allow you room.
- D. **Once the busses have gone the first car at point 3 will be signaled to move up.**
- E. The first car will pull all the way forward to point 5. The vehicles behind that lead car will move forward until the back of the line extends to point 4.
- F. **Here is where you must be alert.** When you reach point 3 and see that moving to point 4 would block the driveway, **WAIT AT POINT 3** until the line moves forward again.
- G. **Courtesy Note:** (while we are still dealing with a long line of vehicles) **drivers – please do not pull from point 1 directly to point 4 in front of cars still waiting at point 3;** that just wouldn't be very nice. If there is no waiting line at point 3, you may pull right up to point 4 and beyond.
